- Full-Time: \$17,215
- General Fee: \$400
- Part-Time (11.0 or less) : \$1,350
- Part-Time General Fee: \$205 per semester

- Parking Registration Fee (yearly): \$100
- Parking Registration Fee (half-year): \$60
- General Fee for all students (per semester): \$95
- Graduate Application: \$30
